Products to be used:

AGRIMEC MITICIDE/INSECTICIDE
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 18 g/L ABAMECTIN as their only active constituent.

VANTAL UPGRADE MITICIDE/INSECTICIDE
PLUS ANY OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCT

Containing: 36 g/L ABAMECTIN as their only active constituent.

Critical Use Comments:

Two Spotted Mite Resistance Management Strategy:

DO NOT apply more than 2 abamectin sprays per crop. In addition, abamectin should not be applied in 2 consecutive crops without an unrelated chemical (non group 6A miticide) being used in between. That is, alternate abamectin with approved miticides from other chemical groups. Include cultural control methods as part of an integrated pest management strategy in addition to chemical control.

Apply in sufficient volume to obtain even coverage and penetration of plants. Preferably apply before build-up of mite numbers. If mite numbers exceed 5 mites per compound leaf, use the higher rate. Reapply as pest numbers indicate. Allow at least 28 days between applications and DO NOT use more than 2 abamectin sprays per crop

Withholding Periods:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 2 days after last application

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food for 2 days after last application.

Jurisdiction:

NSW, QLD, SA, WA, TAS, NT and the ACT only.

(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their 'Control of Use' legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in VIC.)

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.
