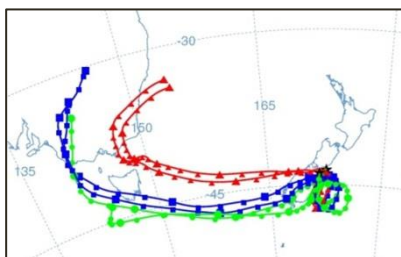


# Half-Day Surveillance Workshop
