Crop	Pest	Product + Rate
Sweet potatoes	Aphids, Thrips, Jassids, and Organophosphate susceptible Two Spotted Mite and Wireworm.	100g/kg products: Early crops: 17-23 kg/ha. Main crops: 23-29kg/ha. 200g/kg products: Early crops: 8.5-11.5 kg/ha. Main crops: 11.5-14.5kg/ha.

Critical Use Comments:

- Distribute granules evenly in the furrow or band granules on each side of the row at planting.
- Apply higher rate in very heavy soils or where organic matter is very high.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT HARVEST FOR 13 WEEKS AFTER APPLICATION.

Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit as their *Control-of-Use* legislation means that an APVMA permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that state.

Additional Conditions:

This Permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.
