Exotic pests like this Brown marmorated stink bug could destroy your crop and become a nuisance in your home and sheds.

While there are strict import conditions in place to protect us from new pests and diseases, as a grower you should always be vigilant to signs of pests and disease in your crop.

If you think you have found something unusual, report it to the **Exotic Plant Pest Hotline** on **1800 084 881**.

Early detection and reporting provides the best chance of eradication and maintaining access to markets.

Here are some of the things you can do to protect your property:

- Use clean seed and healthy plant stock. Always check before you import seed or plant material from overseas – **[agriculture.gov.au/import](http://agriculture.gov.au/import)**.
