

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF A REGISTERED AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF PYTHIUM AND RHIZOCTONIA IN BEETROOT

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. Products to be used:

UNIFORM FUNGICIDE (APVMA No. 69673)

Containing: 124 g/L METALAXYL-M and 322 g/L AZOXYSTROBIN as the only active

constituents.

RESTRAINT:

DO NOT apply more than 400 mL product per hectare.

Directions for Use:

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply as an in-furrow directed spray at planting.
- Use a minimum spray volume of 50 L/ha
- DO NOT apply more than 1 application per crop.
- Position the spray so the fungicide is applied just prior to seed placement so that the majority of the chemical is under the seed.
- Avoid spraying the seed directly or crop injury may occur.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.
