Containing: 480 g/L METRIBUZIN as their only active constituent.

CAMPBELL DORADO 700WG HERBICIDE [APVMA No. 52988]

Plus other REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 700 g/kg METRIBUZIN as their only active constituent.

TOMAHAWK HERBICIDE [APVMA No. 51313]

Plus other REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 750 g/kg METRIBUZIN as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Restrains:

DO NOT APPLY AFTER THE 4-LEAF STAGE IN CARROTS.

DO NOT MAKE MORE THAN TWO APPLICATIONS PER CROP.

Critical Use Comments:

- Pre-emergent applications may be made post-planting and prior to emergence, while post-emergent applications may be made up until the carrots have four true leaves.
- Make a maximum of two (2) applications per crop by broadcast/foliar application using a calibrated boom sprayer, with a spray volume of 300-500 L/ha.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: Do not graze for 14 DAYS after application.

Jurisdiction:

QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.

Export of Produce:

Finite residues of metribuzin may be found in treated carrots. Before application to a crop for export, users are advised to check with their industry body for standards in the proposed export markets.
