This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Product to be used:

TRAMAT 500 SC SELECTIVE HERBICIDE [APVMA No. 39508]

Plus other REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 500 g/L ETHOFUMESATE as the only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Crop Type	Target Weeds	Application Rate
BULB ONIONS	Certain broadleaf and grass weeds as per product labels	600 mL – 1.2 L product / ha

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply one (1) application only after 2-leaf stage of crop growth.
- Apply in accordance with Directions for Use as stated in the product label for onions.
- Apply via calibrated boom sprayer or similar equipment using sufficient water volume to achieve thorough coverage of the crop.
- DO NOT add wetting agent.
- Observe all label *Restrictions*.
- DO NOT rotate with crops other than beet crops for 6 months after application.

### Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 10 WEEKS after application.

### Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES

### Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use the products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.

### *To Avoid Crop Damage*

Bulb onions are not known to be sensitive to ethofumesate based herbicide products when used in accordance with the application rates, conditions of use and other cautionary statements listed on this permit and the product label. However, the herbicide product has not been fully evaluated for crop safety on all cultivars/varieties, or in all situations where treatment may be undertaken. Users should treat a small area prior to whole crop treatment and ascertain the reaction before treating a larger area or the whole crop.

### *Export of Treated Produce*

Bulb onions are not considered a major trade commodity and therefore there is unlikely to be any undue risk to trade with respect to issuance of this permit. However, if treated produce is to be exported, due account should be taken of the residue definition and residue limits/import tolerances of importing countries and any residues must not exceed those requirements of the importing country.
