PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

FOR CONTROL OF PYTHIUM DAMPING OFF IN SPINACH AND SILVERBEET.

PERMIT NUMBER – PER85003

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

THIS PERMIT IS IN FORCE FROM 19 FEBRUARY 2018 TO 28 FEBRUARY 2023.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

RANMAN 400 SC FUNGICIDE (66411)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 400 g/L CYAZOFAMID as the only active constituent, and

Directions for Use:

Crop	Disease	Rate
Spinach and silverbeet (field grown)	<i>Pythium</i> damping off (<i>Pythium</i> spp.)	200 mL product / ha

Critical Use Comments:

- DO Not wait for disease to appear. Make the first application to the soil as a directed, post-transplant or post planting application. The directed application should be made as a band 10 to 15 cm wide over the seed line or transplants.
- Use a spray volume of 400 – 500 L water/ha
- Apply via ground rig boom sprayers applying sufficient water to obtain thorough and uniform coverage of foliage.
- Apply a maximum of six (6) foliar applications per crop at a minimum re-treatment interval of 7-10 days.
- When applying *Ranman 400 SC* consecutively, apply a maximum of three (3) consecutive sprays, then switch to a fungicide of another chemical (mode of action) group.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 3 days after application.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut treated crop for stock food.

Jurisdiction:

ALL States (except Vic.)

(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their 'control-of-use' legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in Victoria).

Additional Conditions:

This Permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the Details and Conditions of this permit.

To Avoid Crop Damage:

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated under all growing conditions. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.
