Tomato potato psyllid



Help protect our horticulture industries

Tomato potato psyllid (TPP) is a tiny sap-sucking insect that feeds on tomato, potato, capsicum, chilli, goji berry, tamarillo, eggplant and sweet potato.

TPP has been found in Western Australia — this is the first time TPP has been detected on mainland Australia.

While its currently contained to WA, commercial vegetable growers and home gardeners should check for signs of TPP and report anything unusual to the Exotic Plant Pest Hotline.

This is an initiative of the national TPP Transition to Management Plan.
